Weekly trends can fluctuate due to security conditions in the region, the political climate in Niger and neighbouring countries, presence of migrants at the flow monitoring points and availability of transport and opportunities. The previous two weeks constitue the highest flows of outgoing and incoming migrants recorded by the flow monitoring. The increase in migrants has mainly been through the flow monitoring point of Seguedine while Arlit has remained constant.


Evolution of representation of 6 main nationalities reported in outgoing

Recorded nationalities present in the migratory flows



Evolution of representation of 5 main nationalities reported in incoming




FUNDING

The data collected provides a snapshot of migrant movements through the region. The numbers are collected from primary sources and do not claim to reflect all migrants passing through the flow monitoring points.









Route used to and from Arlit:




