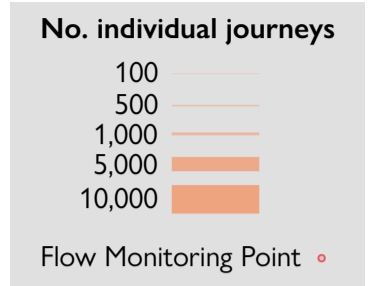
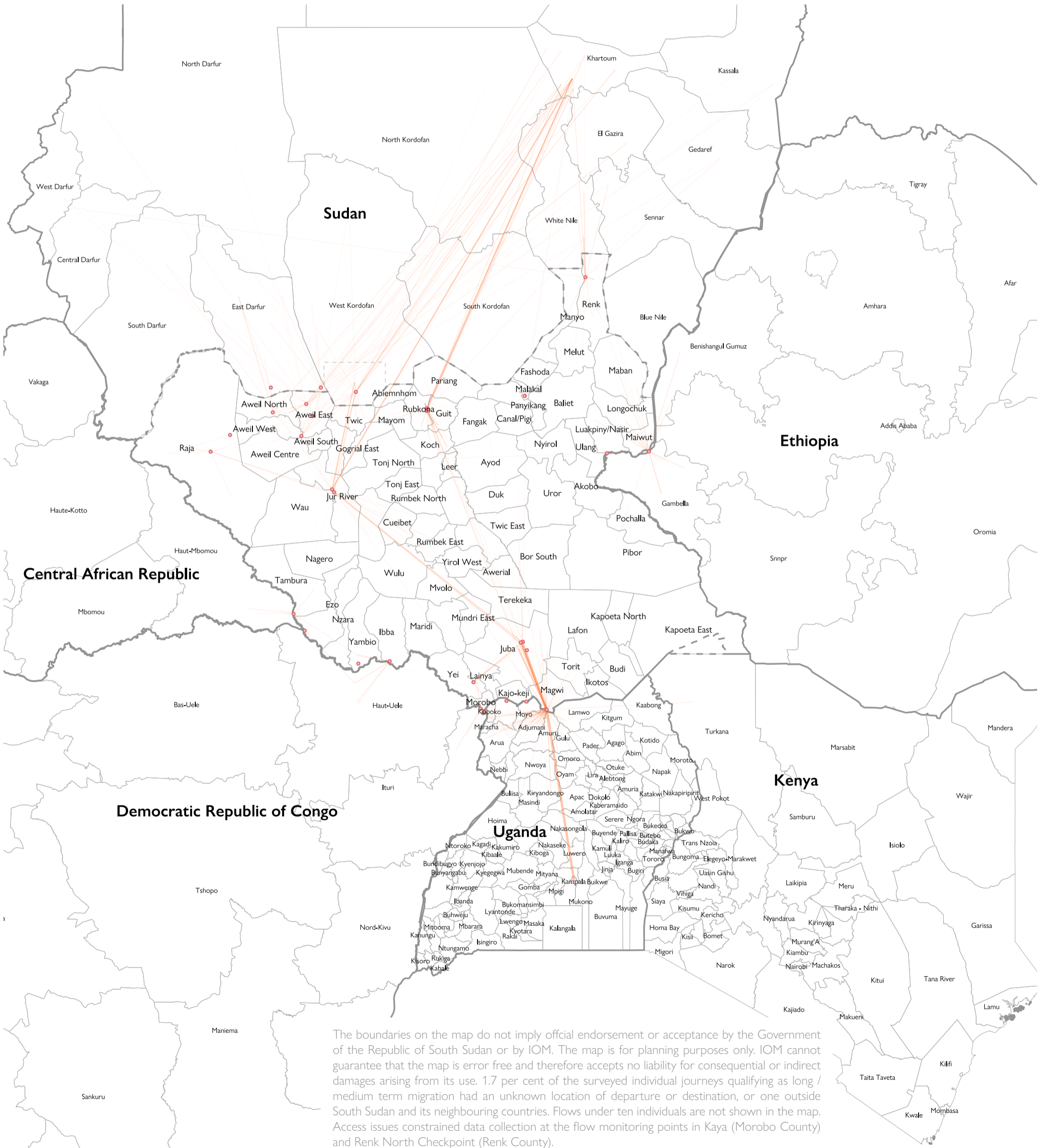


Figures are only indicative of existing trends among respondents at the active FMPs since DTM does not have full coverage of cross-border or internal flows. Participation in the survey is voluntary and anonymous. Flows are mapped at the second administrative level for neighbouring countries and at the county or payam level for South Sudan. Flows to and from camps are mapped using UNHCR or IOM camp coordinates where available. Migration flows are considered to be long / medium term if the group spent over 3 months at the location of departure and intends to spend over 6 months at destination, regardless of the reason for travel.
