



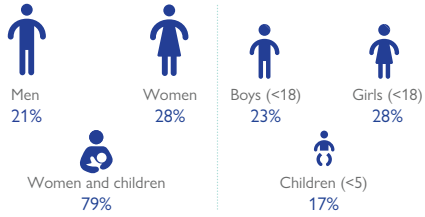

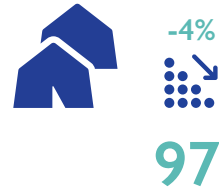
#### Demographic composition:



#### In camps/camp-like settings:

- 29% of IDPs have been previously displaced.
- 19% of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.
- 35% of IDPs indicated not having potable water.
- 34% of IDPs cited blanket/mat as the most needed NFI.
- 32% of education facilities are located off-sites.
- 59% of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.
- 41% do not have access to regular medication.
- 40% of IDPs do not have access to food support.  
in 73% of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.

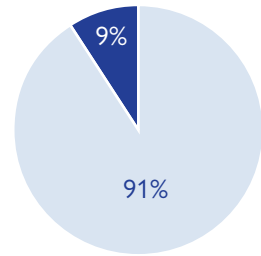

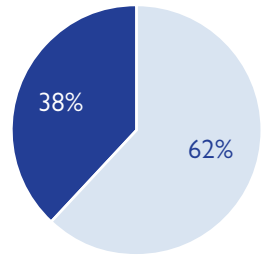
#### IDP in camps/camp-like settings



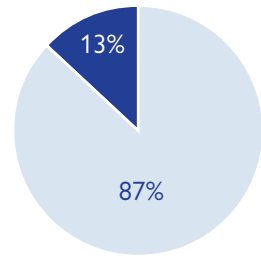
#### Sites by status



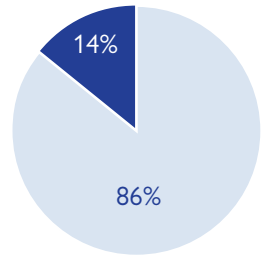
#### Population by site status



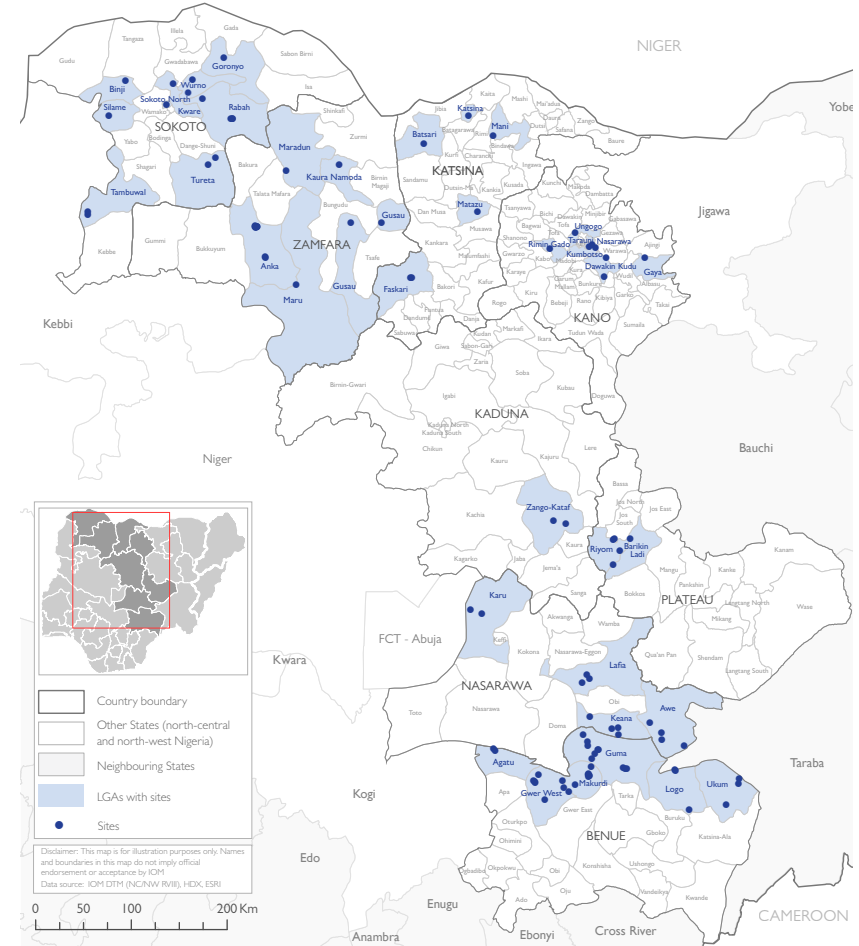
#### Sites by classification
