

The current outbreak of COVID-19 has affected global mobility in the form of various travel disruptions, restrictions and blockages. To better understand how COVID-19 affects global mobility, IOM is developing a global mobility database by mapping and gathering data from the locations, status and different restrictions of Points of Entry (PoE) globally.

As of 30th March 2020 (17:00 CET), data for the baseline assessment of Points of Entry (PoE) has been collected and processed for **138** countries, territories and areas (CTAs), including **1,993** Points of Entry.

Official and Operational Status of Reported Points of Entry

- The PoE Baseline database contains information on 1,993 Points of Entry.
- These consist of 427 airports, 142 internal transit points, 1,160 land border points and 264 sea border points.
- Of the 1,993 PoE assessed, 940 were closed for entry and exit, 22 were closed for exit, 101 were closed for entry, 650 were partially closed, and 93 were unknown.
- Of the assessed PoE, 92 per cent were reported to be official points of entry, while 8% were unofficial or unknown.
- In 26 CTAs, all reported Points of Entry are closed for both entry and exit: Angola, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Burundi, Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Curaçao, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Guinea-Bissau, Guyana, Kazakhstan,, Kuwait, Madagascar, Malta, Mongolia, North Macedonia, Panama, Peru, Republic of Moldova, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Tajikistan, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, Kosovo*
- In 5 CTAs, all reported Points of Entry are closed for entry: Belize, Cambodia, Cyprus, Morocco, Sri Lanka

Restrictions at reported Points of Entry

- Of the 1,993 assessed Points of Entry, 1,713 (86%) have some form of restrictions/measures in place.
- 792 medical measures are imposed in all assessed PoE.


Top three commonly imposed type of restrictions/measures (of reported PoE):

- I. Movement Restriction to this location (67% of reported PoE)
- 2. Movement Restriction from this location (63% of reported PoE)
- 3. Medical Measures (26% of reported PoE)

Top three commonly imposed medical measures (of reported PoE having medical measures):

- 1. Routine health screening (35% of reported PoE having medical measures)
- 2. COVID-19 screening (33% of reported PoE having medical measures)
- 3. Isolation measures (14% of reported PoE having medical measures)


Type of Restrictions/Measures Imposed at Points of Entry per Region (Multiple-choice)





Duration of Restriction / Measures and Affected Population Categories at Reported Points of Entry

- The most common restriction period ranged between **14 days to one month** (49% of all reported PoE).
- The most commonly affected population category at Points of Entry is Regular Travellers
- IDPs are mostly affected at PoE in Africa
- Returnees and nationals are mostly affected at PoE in Asia
- Irregular Migrants are mostly affected at PoE in Europe



Methodology

DTM utilizes in-country expertise of IOM offices around the world to collect relevant information in a systematic and structured approach. Data is collected from the following observation points:

- Points of entry and exit (airports, land borders and seaport)
- Transit points (in country locations on crossroads between cities and regions)
- Areas (regions or cities in the country)
