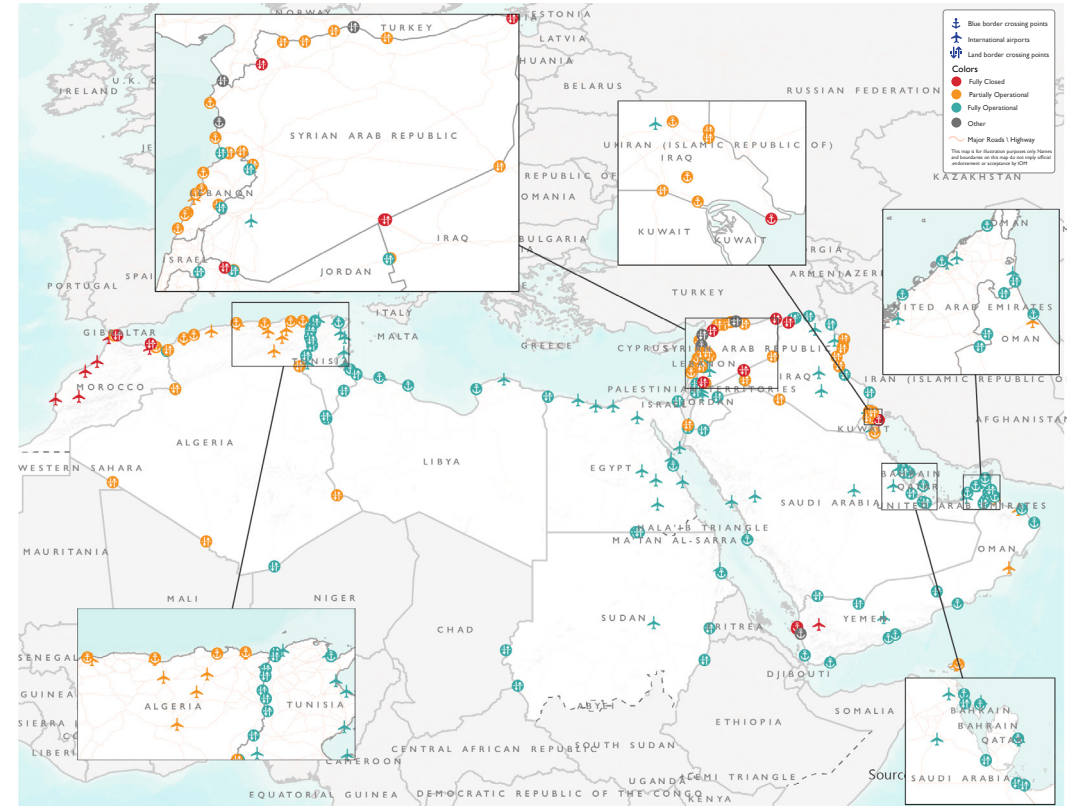
An increasing number of countries (14) is implementing partial mobility restriction measures at national level, while only three countries in the Region are not implementing any measure at national level.

There are only 4 countries that are under National Emergency

In the end of November Morocco decided to close its six international airports to prevent the spread of the new variant of COVID-19 and these restrictions were maintained in December.

A slight reduction of mobility restrictions is recorded during the reporting period in several countries and Points of Entry.
