




Flow Monitoring Points | Migrant Arrivals and Yemeni Returns from Saudi Arabia in May 2020



The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) monitors key migrant arrival and Yemeni return locations on Yemen's northern border with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) and southern coastal border. Enumerators placed at Flow Monitoring Points (FMPs) record arrivals of migrants and Yemeni nationals' returns in order to identify different patterns and types of migrants entering the country. Access constraints limit the ability to collect data at some migrant arrival points. IOM estimates that 1,195 migrants entered Yemen in addition to 2,089 Yemeni returns from KSA during May 2020 bringing the number of migrants who have arrived in Yemen in 2020 to 30,868 and the number of Yemeni returns from KSA to 13,054.
