Mauritania: Most (19 of 27) of the PoEs assessed were closed or partially closed at the time of the assessment. 8 of the 11 main PoEs remained partially open to allow the transport of goods from and to neighboring countries.

Burkina Faso: on average 22 migrants per day, using bypasses of official crossing points in Seytenga

Chad: 574 individuals were in quarantine at several points of entry points along the Chad – Cameroon border, including 352 individuals in Koutéré, 71 in Pobame, 68 in Bongor, 37 in Gaya, 27 in Youé and 19 in Fianga.

Guinea: Establishment of the Entry points and cross-border collaboration technical working group of the Response Monitoring Commission.

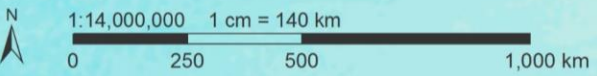
Mali: 17 Migrants (including 11 men, 5 women and 1 Child aged 5) of various nationalities stranded in Gogui

Nigeria: In a DTM assessment, 86,657 respondents - or 4 per cent of all identified IDPs as per DTM Round 32 - were interviewed for a range of COVID-19 related indicators. Key informant interviews and focus group discussions were the primary methods used for the assessment and the findings were corroborated with physical on-ground observations.

Nigeria: 868 movements were observed at nearly 22 points of entry in the states of Adamawa and Borno, affected by the conflict. Of the total of these recorded movements, most came from the Far North of Cameroon.
